Exceptionally warm conditions all accept last 2 weeks of January amazing we had so many birds it obviously does not affect the migration



A great season with most groups doing extremely well and even if we couldn't shoot them we saw plenty each day.

Day on the LLyn. Peninsula

All I would say is if your looking to book do it sooner than later I expect we will be fully booked in Wales by end of March. 100% take up from groups.

Llyn Peninsula

Note we are conducting work on the Llyn Peninsula woodlands to prepare rides up giving greater access in the woods to beat out the birds also this should encourage more woodcock to roost - more edges more landing areas in woodlands 'more woodcock'. We are taking extra ground on the Llyn Peninsula for the 2021-22 season so should have another 6 days back too back over mixed woodlands. On our mountain block at Cwm Pennant the lower slopes offering a full days shooting are being strimmed heavily in September to allow shoot 'avenues' and accessible paths allowing greater access into and out of these areas . There is 65% of the ground we have never shot?? which has huge gorse banks again we will strimming paths and cut into the area to give more edges. So a challenging Autumn work programme.

Angelsey - our current ground performed mixed wild birds were excellent all season but the farmer owning the land is removing gorse/ digging in marshland at a fast rate which has already lost us 1/2 a days hunting or 4-5 drives but Well done Steph Armsden the keeper he's crested 3 new drives to compensate.

Wigtown - had 1 group only this season and had 2 decent days but nothing to shout about.

We have so many photographs its difficult to put them all on so I hope i'm giving at least each group 1-2 each to get across the enjoyment of our hunting and the scenery you hunt


