WOODCOCK NEWS END OF SEASON 2023-24

Best bag ever over two days 61 and 69 respectively on Angelsey



The Rain was non-stop, the water on the ground was staggering but we did get good numbers of Woodcock in all areas maybe one week was slow but in general we had 30-50 lifts daily poor day being 20 lifts and we had a few of those. Snipe were decent wild duck despite the splashes everywhere made a consistent appearance maybe not in the numbers we are used to.

We have maintained our ground and taken some new stuff in but we didn't use a lot of it but that's not an issue. And we shot most areas 2-3 times only in there 10 week period.

Note we have conducted ride clearance work on the Llyn Peninsula at Cwm Pennant its a pleasure to beat around now woodlands easier to access and shot from, cutting the area's with huge briar spread gave more edges and drop in zones along with birds able to feed directly from them roosting . So a challenging costly Autumn work programme. We will continue when the ground dry's out as some areas we just could not complete this past year.

Angelsey - We are still looking to add a woodland close to our current ground.

Wigtown - had 2 groups only this season and had respectively 69 birds shot over 5 days total shooting.

Lyn Peninsula

A great overall season with lots of new grounds I would say we under shot a lot of ground Woodcock were good apart from 1 week and who knows were shooting wild bird after all they just move that simple but were enough to make the two days hard for the beaters but thats what they are said for, Ive already mentioned the clearance work at Cwm Pennant what a difference it has made to birds and beaters.

Again don't leave it to late to book I don't want deposit's until March end as that's the new financial year. But I will accept bookings and send invoices out in March.

Flighting - the large woodlands seed the shoot areas on a daily basis - but our night flighting went well in most areas
