We kicked off the third week in Mid November without the first moon at the end of the month, plenty of birds seen and lifted - shot. We can expect a big influx as usual and I am hoping the woodcock have recovered from the severe two winters we had in 2010 and 2011 when 3 and 5 week bans were imposed by the government, we were not disappointed and despite wet unseasonal weather for a second year after the moon in November birds appeared in big numbers, and through

December bags of 20 shot a day were common, if the guns were good. We have decided to let pointer hunters minimum 2 per group to 'FREE HUNT' with long range supervision this worked well for us and the pointer boys. With two new agents one from France and another from Italy bookings were good, we have a group of 8 from Finland booked ahead for 28-29th December 2013 and a UK group just choosing dates. Such is the pulling power of Bute.

January saw very warm weather for 2-3 days and as quick as birds appear they disappeared but came back in gradual numbers around the 9-10th and remain here. Winter duck just never appeared and apart from the odd one or two sightings it never happened! Geese were present but not in normal numbers.
