Bookings are looking good for the coming season on all areas

I've attached our end of season news letter for your attention, and theres a comprehensive report from around the UK which should be interesting for any devoted woodcock hunter.

Note we expect a 75% booking on all weeks from Mid Novemebr through January end.

Although Bute is our best overall island for woodcock/pheasant, Mull of Kintyre has excellent partridge and duck as well .

We are offering Wigtown in Galloway for £200 per gun this season as it was under utilised last year and overall its our best rounded hunt I do offer dawn woodcock flighting here if your happy to get up and get on your flight peg while still dark. best dawn flight has been 9 birds shot in galloway, 2009.

but we average 3-4 kills, in general.

The Llyn peninsula was our first North Wales woodcock area and produced good daily bags but it was a learning

curve and we realise 2 days maximum is what we can do on a driven basis so a third day would be walked up on wetland and small gorse banks and thicket's the big surprise was how many birds sat in clear fell ground in an open situation (the same applied on Bute where a large area of gorse had been cleared.
